The Most Rev. Mark MacDonald became the Anglican Church of Canada's first National Indigenous Anglican Bishop in 2007, after serving as bishop of the U.S. Episcopal Diocese of Alaska for 10 years. In 2019, Bishop MacDonald was elevated to Archbishop.

This was a home-coming of sorts for Archbishop MacDonald, who had attended Wycliffe College in Toronto and served as a priest in Mississauga, Ont.

He holds a B.A. in religious studies and psychology from the College of St. Scholastica in Duluth, Minn., an M.A. in divinity from Wycliffe College, and did post-graduate work at Luther-Northwestern Theological Seminary in Minneapolis.



He has had a long and varied ministry, holding positions in Mississauga, Ont., Duluth, Minn., Tomah, Wis., Mauston, Wis., Portland, Ore., and the southeast regional mission of the Diocese of Navajoland. He is the board chair for Church Innovations, Inc., and a third order Franciscan.

He is the author and contributor to many books and resources. He and his wife Virginia have 3 children.

Mark Regis stated: "I am convinced that it is no mere 'coincidence' that Abp Mark was available on this July 18th which is marked by the Mark 10.13-16 passage. Jesus resolutely proclaimed that children are dearly cherished in the heart of God. The fact that Indigenous children were treated in such a way is a terrible affront to generations of Indigenous families, and a terrible affront to God. The legacy of residential schools has produced generational trauma that continues to damage lives today.

The path to healing and reconciliation lies before us, as Christians and as citizens of Canada. We look forward to a wise and compassionate Indigenous voice to help us learn and point us in a direction of action that will bring the justice that God calls us to."


